

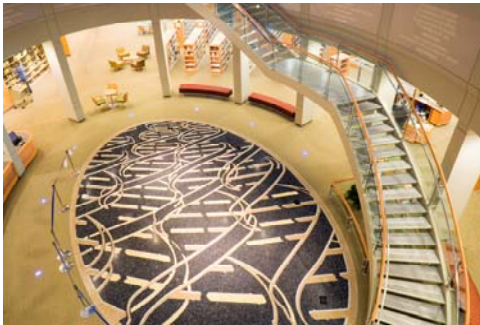
CCA Wins Prestigious *StarNet* Design Award
